The Path Project received 3 desktop computers and 3 monitors to help their Spanish students from middle and high school and to provide essential resources in this day and age.

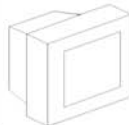


Compcommunity foundation donated a laptop to the Lorenzo-Vaquero Family. The laptop will help with their communication, homework and to support each other.
